RACE RULES FOR OFF ROAD DERBY

1. All Competitors and Mechanics must sign waiver of liability on the entry form. Only one entry per event per person. Entry is non-transferable.
2. Driver must wear full face type helmet with face shield or goggles, neck brace, long sleeved shirt and long pants at all times during race.
3. Only persons who have signed the release will be allowed in the pit area.
4. No trucks carry alls, Jeeps, or 4 wheel drive vehicles allowed.
5. You must use the same car in the feature that you ran in your heat race.
6. Anyone under the influence or using alcohol or any controlled substance at the event will be disqualified along with the car and crew.
7. Any driver, car owner, or mechanic involved in any fight, demonstration, or disturbance on the track, in the pits or surrounding area before, during, or after the race shall be subject to disqualification and forfeit any awards won.
8. A driver will be disqualified if a door comes open during a race.
9. Driver must keep all limbs inside vehicle during race.
10. If found to be teaming or using the buddy system - disqualification will result.
11. **Any leakage of fuel is immediate disqualification.**
12. There will be no intentional head on collisions or hitting of driver's door.
13. In the event of a rollover, race will stop while car is righted. If car is given the OK by officials, it may continue racing.
14. After lead car finishes, all cars should cross finish line if possible.
15. There will be a driver's meeting one half hour prior to start of event. This meeting is mandatory for all drivers and mechanics.
16. The Fair or any of its associates will not be responsible for any cars, parts, or personal property before, during, or after the race.
17. Officials reserve the right to reject any and all registrations. Cars decorated in poor taste will be rejected.
18. Entry fees will not be refunded for "no shows" or for cars that do not pass inspection.
19. A \$50.00 protest fee is required to contest another car. All protests must be made within one hour of the completion of event.
20. All cars must have a number plate on the roof.

Flags will be used during the event

GREEN	-	Start Race	BLACK	-	Disqualified, Go to Pitts

Tech inspection will close at 5:45 unless announced differently, all cars will be inspected by this time or Standby's will be placed

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OFF ROAD DERBY - TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

1. A vertical radiator support, stretching the width of your frame, the height from frame to core support, NO MORE than 18" kickers back, NO MORE than 2" x 2" in diameter will be allowed. Radiator must remain in stock position!
2. Stock gas tanks must be removed. An auxiliary tank must be securely fastened and located behind the front seat. A fire shield must be placed between the driver and the fuel tank. The fire shield must be securely fastened around and completely covering the fuel tank to keep gasoline from splashing on the driver if it should get ruptured. Tank shall be vented to outside of driver's compartment.
3. Gas cans are not allowed as fuel tanks.
4. Auxiliary fuel tanks must be steel or neoprene (USCG approved) and no larger than 6.6 gallons capacity. Approved fuel cell or portable outboard boat motor tank allowed.
5. Any leakage of fuel will lead to immediate disqualification. Electric fuel pump must have plainly labeled on/off switch within drivers reach and be clearly labeled unless stock electric fuel pump is wired to ignition switch.
6. All glass and debris must be removed from car before entering the fairgrounds. This includes windows, mirrors, headlights and windshields. Plexiglas may be used in place of windshield.
7. Rear corners of hood must be secured with chain or cable to keep hood from coming into driver's compartment. **MUST HAVE** a bar installed across center of windshield, from cowl to roof.
8. Chrome moldings, antenna, sun visors, and any other dangerous or loose objects must be removed and car must be clean of all debris before car enters the fairgrounds.
9. Roll bars will be allowed but must be of quality materials with quality workmanship **and may not extend past rear seat.**
10. Only one automotive type battery allowed. Battery location is open. Battery must be secured and covered.
11. Engine and transmission mounts may be chained or welded.
12. Fenders may be cut out for clearance only. Bumpers must extend width of car. **Bumper covers must be removed.**
13. All cars must have working brakes to enter. Brakes must work for all events.
14. All cars must have a minimum 12" hole cut in hood above air cleaner.
15. All doors must be securely fastened by welding or by chain or wire. Welding is limited to two tabs front and two tabs rear, no longer than 6" in **TOTAL** length.
16. Driver's door must have original interior or additional padding. Driver's door may be reinforced.
17. Driver's window must be covered by either a screen or net. This may be attached with zip ties or other means easily removable.
18. Hood and trunk must be fastened down with wire or chain. Hood must not be welded shut. Hood pins or bolts with washers not permitted. Hood and trunk must remain down at all times during race.
19. Trunk lid must remain in stock location and may have a 12" inspection hole.

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20. Rear bottom seat cushions must be removed.
21. All cars must have a **LEGIBLE** number plate on roof. Numbers and/or letters should be a minimum of 10" tall. Number and/or letters on number plates are up to judges' discretion. If number and number plate are unacceptable, both will be replaced at driver's expense.
22. No trailer hitches.
23. Absolutely no altering, welding or reinforcement of springs, frame, or other suspension components. All components must be stock.
24. One shock per wheel in stock location. No spring jacks, blocked shocks, coil over shocks, or air shocks. ¼" maximum diameter cable may be used on springs to limit suspension travel
25. Front bumper shock tubes may be chained or welded to prevent them from pulling out.
26. Welding or chaining any parts to frame is prohibited. Except engine and transmission.
27. It is strongly suggested that each car be equipped with a minimum 2 ½ pound ABC fire extinguisher within reach of driver and securely mounted.
28. Tires must be DOT approved, 6 ply, 29" tall - maximum rating must be visible. No recaps. No screws are allowed attaching the tire to the rim. All tires, including spares, must go through tech inspection. All wheel weights must be removed.
29. No Double side wall tires Allowed.
30. Throttle must have positive return springs.
31. One vertical post behind driver's seat from floor to roof with minimum 6" x 6" x 1/8" plate on each end must be in place unless an adequate roll bar is installed. Post must be minimum of 1 1/2" schedule 40 pipe (well pipe) or 2" x 2" x 1/8" square tubing.
32. All drivers must be 18 years old or older. 16 & 17 years old will be allowed with parental signature!!!
33. An 18" x 18" skid plate will be allowed.
34. All airbags must be removed.

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Any items removed from car during event are to be removed from grounds after event

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
