Cage count process.

Currently there is no limit to cages. If the barn is full, I will contact you and put a max of 7 cages for each youth club member. Circle number of cages needed: 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 if more _____ (**Only allowed one poultry per class**)

Bedding, Feed, and dishes are provided.

Do you plan on feeding and watering your poultry? Yes or No (This is for figuring purchasing feed quantity.) If you do feed them, please have them fed by 9am and recheck the water in the afternoon around 3pm.

Check in and Check out Process.

The poultry can be checked in on Monday of the fair week. Check in with free pullorum testing from 10am -12am. This will be located on the east side of the poultry barn. Per-state law transport cages cannot be stored in barns.

No Entries will be released until 6:30 p.m. Saturday. If checked out early this will forfeit any premiums. Please take poultry from cages, place dishes in labeled bins, pick up ribbons and take poultry home. Poultry can stay later than 6:30 but need to be taken home by 9pm. Gate entry for pick up will be through camping area Gate F at 5200 40th. You can come early, and the fair board will stage you on the grounds.

Showmanship Information

Showmanship, please circle the class the youth club member will be entering (You need to do Showmanship class to be paid for breed classes):

The poultry show starts at 8:30 am on Wednesday in the rabbit barn. Poultry Judging will follow the American Standard of Perfection as authority in competition. Poultry will be judged by APA/ABA standards.
